**Road Report** – review road inspection and Anderson Bros. bid for Polymastic

- \*Bid from Anderson is for Lindove Lane, Cree Bay Circle, West Cree Bay Circle they looked at Bay Shore Dr and Ivy Bay both roads cracks were too small Motion was made to Authorize this work to be done Westerberg made motion, Radtke seconded; none opposed, motion passed unanimously.
- \*Discussion on what other roads to Polymastic this year Stewart's Bay, Upper Cullen Rd, Pelican Lake Rd (by the beach to Lake Edward) Westerberg will contact Anderson for bid
- \*Mill & overlay in next couple of year Little Pelican Tr, Beaver Dam & Lakeview Ln
- \*Chip Seal with the county a couple other roads as well
- \*Channel Ln on site inspection will be scheduled with Anderson Bros to discussion options as road is getting to the point it has to be repaired.

### Committee Reports -

\*Bill from Lake Edward for Crack Sealing Red Oak Rd as well as update the Road agreement – we have cracked sealed in 2019, 2017, 2015 & 2013 as well as before. The only bill we have sent

was in 2013 for half the materials used. The agreement includes brushing, mowing & tree removal. Board decided to let this sit, wait for a proposal & then send a response. Wallin mentioned an article regarding road agreements from MAT she had seen, will email to board to review

\*Mission – no one can find a real road agreement. We plow and maintain Canthook North of Pelican Ln, Pelican way & Pelican Beach – Buck will get in contact with them regarding getting this updated

### Zoning Issues -

\*Moss – small deck, East side of the house, 45' from the Lake – Very private area. Motion was made to write a letter to county stating our approval of them granting the variance – Morris made the motion, Radtke seconded, vote passed 2-1 with Westerberg dissenting because of concern that we keep granting variances and then the neighbors go for it and keep getting closer and closer to the lake.

\* Sutten (Radtke will not vote or comment other than facts due to relative) – Channel has a 100 ft setback, looking to have variance as it is a not moving channel. Motion was made to defer to the county on this decision – Morris made motion, Westerberg seconded; vote passed 2 and 1 abstaining

## New, Old, Other Business -

**Pequot Fire Board** – Morris attended, contracted township participate. Notes from the meeting – they are no longer asking for money to replace tanker truck immediately, Moose Lake is pulling their contract, & Jenkins is looking at options
